Several ideas for future activities were discussed, including enrolling HRSMS as a member of NRG (passed), printing and distribution of a club flyer (passed), making a club donation to the Yorktown Project (no action), and organizing a model exhibition for the HRSMS 20th anniversary in 1987 (for further discussion). The meeting adjourned for homemade ice cream and discussions about decks and their construction at 2120.
